THE CREATION



- Founded in 2013, we are the first and currently only organization reserving prize money specifically for college students in the sport of distance running.
- 2013 NCAA D1 Legislation changes-permissible to accept prize money to cover sport related expenses over a calendar year
 - Different for D2 and D3 (Event Specific Expenses outside the season)
 - See our website (Eligibility FAQ) for details (CollegiateRunning.org)
- Over 90% of HS TF/XC athletes do not participate in college for various reasons including reduced opportunities.
- Prepare for the future
 - Even if it is 1 class at a time
 - Incentive for top athletes in the form of \$\$

MISSION

- Promote healthy lifestyles among college students through running
- Expand opportunities for college students involved in running
- Provide true collegiate national championships open to all college students currently enrolled in at least one class
- Increase participation among college students in Road,
 Mountain and Trail Running



VISION

- Host national championship events not currently offered at the college level
 - Road, Mountain and Trail Running
 - ➤ NCAA=XC, Indoor, Outdoor only
 - ➤ USATF=All disciplines however nothing specific to college students
 - Void specific to college students

 - High Visibility
 - Elite and social fields inclusively
- Attract elite college runners from all levels
 - PRIZE MONEY
 - Inclusive national champions

PRIZE MONEY

- Open to all members taking at least 1 college course within the time period
 - -(January 1- August 31/September 1- December 31)
- Exhausted NCAA eligibility
 - ➤ No limitations
- NCAA Division 1
 - Actual & necessary expenses for CALENDAR YEAR
- NCAA Division 2 & 3
 - > Actual & necessary expenses for the event
- CRA has awarded over \$120,000 in prize money and travel to College Students since 2014

Did you know?

- Since 2014 over 16,000 college students from across the U.S. have participated in Collegiate Running Association National Championships.
- Since 2014 the Collegiate Running Association and our race partnerships have awarded over \$120,000 in prize money and travel specifically to college students.
- Over the past 5 years (2014-2018) 20 Collegiate Running Association members have qualified for 71 USATF National Teams.
- 2019 marked the 6th consecutive year the Ukrop's Monument Avenue 10K has hosted the Collegiate 10K Road Race National Championships (2020 & 2021 announcement soon).
- 2018 marked the 5th consecutive year the Collegiate Mountain Running National Championships were hosted concurrently with the USATF Championships.

Did you know?

- 2014 Collegiate 10K Road Race National Champion, Paul Chelimo (UNC-Greensboro/Kenya) became a U.S. citizenship and won the Silver medal (2nd- 13:03.90) in the 5,000M in the 2016 Rio Olympic Games and Bronze medal (3rd) in the 2017 IAAF World Outdoor Track & Field Championships (5,000M)
- After PR's of 9:53 (3KSC), 15:45 (5k), 32:37 (10k), 1:14:03 (1/2 marathon) and 2:35 (marathon) Addie Bracy (Univ. of Colorado Denver) transitioned from the track to include mountain and trail races. In 2018 she claimed the Collegiate Mountain Running Championship and a spot on the USMRT. She has since made numerous USATF National Teams in mountain, ultra & trail (MUT) running.
- In the last year, 2016 & 2018 Collegiate Running Association Female Athlete of the Year, **Bethany Sachtleben (GMU/NOVA)** has run 15:46 (5K), 32:39 (10K), 51:08 (15K), 53:40 (10 miles), 1:12:28 (HM) and 2:31:20 (Mar). Since becoming a member she has won \$7,000 in prize money within CRA Championships.
- 2014 and 2015 Collegiate 10K Road Race National Champion, Kellyn Johnson Taylor (Coconino College) ran one of the fastest debut marathons in U.S. history (2:28:40) in 2015
- 2015 Collegiate Running Association Male Athlete of the Year and 2015 Collegiate Trail Race National Champion, Joe Gray (Colorado Bible College) won the 2016 World Mountain Running Championship and 2017 World Snowshoe Running Championship.
- In 2018 the Collegiate Running Association became the first hosted organization partner with AthleteBiz.
- In 2018 the Collegiate Running Association expanded our partnership with <u>Sports Backers Kids</u> <u>Run RVA</u> to promote physical activity to youth across the Richmond, VA area.
